Meigs County teachers and staff will dress in a clean, wholesome, and well-groomed manner that will by no means distract from but will contribute to the learning environment in the classroom. They will dress moderately, in attire that will maintain a standard of respect and professionalism. Teachers shall dress appropriately for all school functions. The following guidelines shall apply to all staff during school hours. This applies to all staff in all buildings except custodians for the regular 180 school days during regular school hours

In addition to skirts, blouses, and dresses, ladies may wear slacks, capri pants, pant suits, and nice skort outfits. No outfit or slit should reach more than three inches above the knee. Tops may be worn tucked in or on the outside as appropriate to the outfit. Male teachers will wear pants or slacks which display no more than four standard pockets. If pants have belt loops, belts should be worn. Shirts should be tucked in.

No denim allowed.

Ladies and men may wear tops without collars (many tops, sweaters, dresses, etc. do not have collars). Jeans and T-shirts will be allowed on designated days (field trips, ballgames, field days, etc.).

Physical education teachers, vocational teachers, coaches, and other teachers on special assignment may dress appropriately for their assignment while on duty with that assignment.
