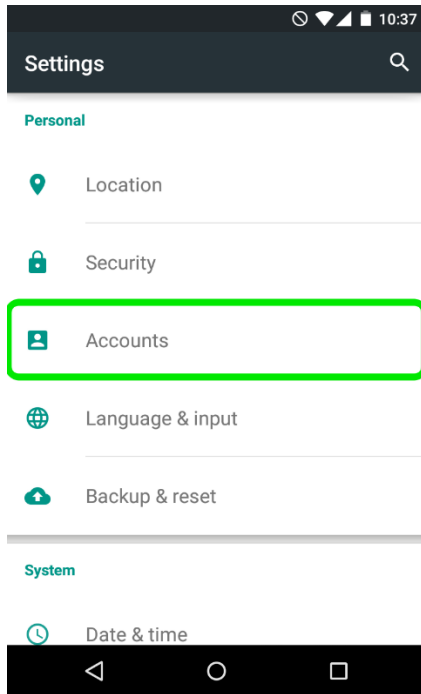
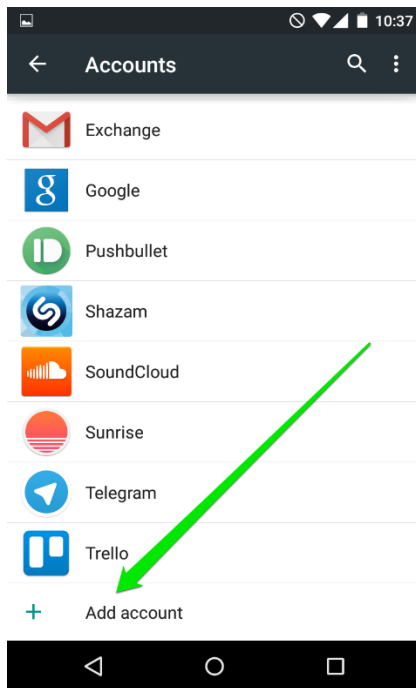


Adding your Meigscounty.net Email to your Android device

1. Open **Settings** of your Android device and tap on **Accounts** menu in section Personal:

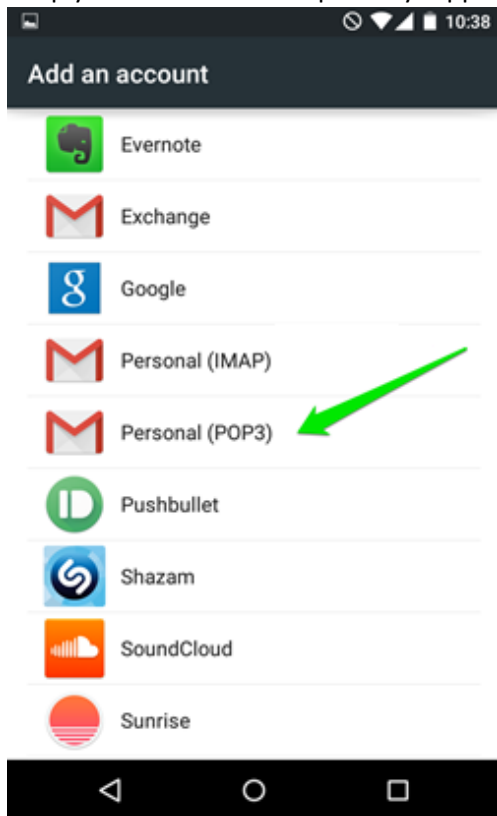


2. Tap on **Add Account** at the very bottom of the screen:

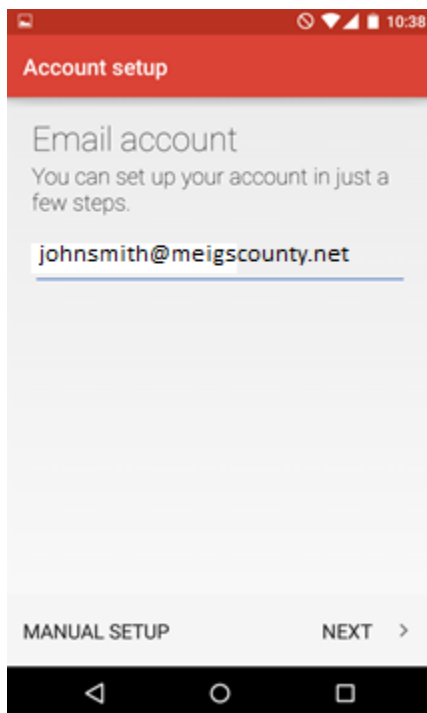


3. On the next screen you will need to choose POP3 account.

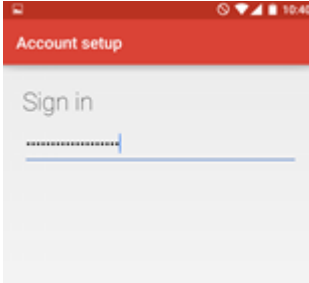
Simply choose the POP3 option by tapping on **Personal (POP3)**



4. The next screen will prompt you to enter your email address. Make sure to type in full Private Email address:



5. Once done, tap **Next** to proceed to the next step.
6. Here you will need to indicate your email account password.



7. Tap **Next** to continue.
8. Here you will need to type in correct POP3 settings depending on the option you choose. Make sure to use the following settings for **POP**:

Username: FirstNameLastName (no spaces)

Password: password for this mailbox

INCOMING Server: mail.meigscounty.net

POP port: 110

Security Type: None



9. Once done, tap **Next** to verify the settings and proceed to **Outgoing Server** settings menu.

10. Here you will need to fill in the corresponding fields as shown below:


SMTP (OUTGOING) Server: mail.meigscounty.net
